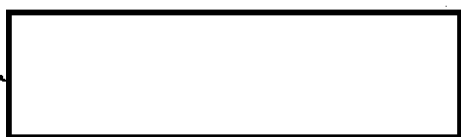



STATEMENT FROM [REDACTED]

I was assigned the 12:00 midnight to 8:00 a.m. shift on 7-12-73.

I got my assignment from the office and was assigned motor patrol from 12:00 midnight to 3:30 a.m., then interior building patrol.

I filled out my vehicle inspection card (top portion) at 12:10 a.m. and the vehicle was parked on the street ~~at~~ the west door. While making the vehicle inspection, I was approached by a man on a motor bike who had entered the compound at the Page gate, and he said he had observed from Page Boulevard that there was a fire.

I immediately got into the vehicle and drove to the southwest corner and observed flames shooting out of the window on the 6th floor. I put the vehicle in reverse and immediately backed from the southwest corner to the west entrance. b7C

I ran inside and reported to the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] that there was a fire on the 6th floor.

I then ran to the west end passenger elevator and proceeded to the 6th floor. Upon elevator doors opening, the undersigned observed very heavy black smoke but no heat. I punched the 4th floor button without exiting. I then exited on the 4th floor and walked east down the hall to stairwell f and walked back up to the 5th floor using stairwell f. When I opened the stairwell door on the 5th floor the smoke was not too bad.

Then I went back up to the 6th floor. The same condition prevailed that was at the elevator door ---- heavy smoke but no heat. I then came back down the stairwell to the 5th floor and went out into the lobby. There was a small amount of smoke.

I walked into the west end office area off the lobby of the 5th floor and called the [REDACTED] and gave a report on the conditions. I told him that I would stay on the 5th floor and wait for the Fire Department.

They arrived and they assessed the situation and decided they needed some more equipment. While waiting for breathing equipment they secured a life line from the top of the stairs on 5 and four or five firemen went up stairwell f onto the 6th floor. They had obtained keys from the undersigned for the penthouse. They unlocked the penthouse door. Upon returning to the 5th floor they reported that there was intense heat in that area.

The undersigned remained on the 5th floor until about 3:00 a.m. when he was ordered by [redacted] to come to first floor Federal Protective Service office area.

At the time of my departure from the 5th floor, the Fire Department had not gotten any water into 6th floor from inside.

Just before departing 5th floor, I opened stairwell entrance door from 5th floor and observed heavy smoke and small amount of heat.

When I departed 5th floor, several firemen were congregated in the snack bar area and seemed to be unoccupied and it appeared they were waiting.

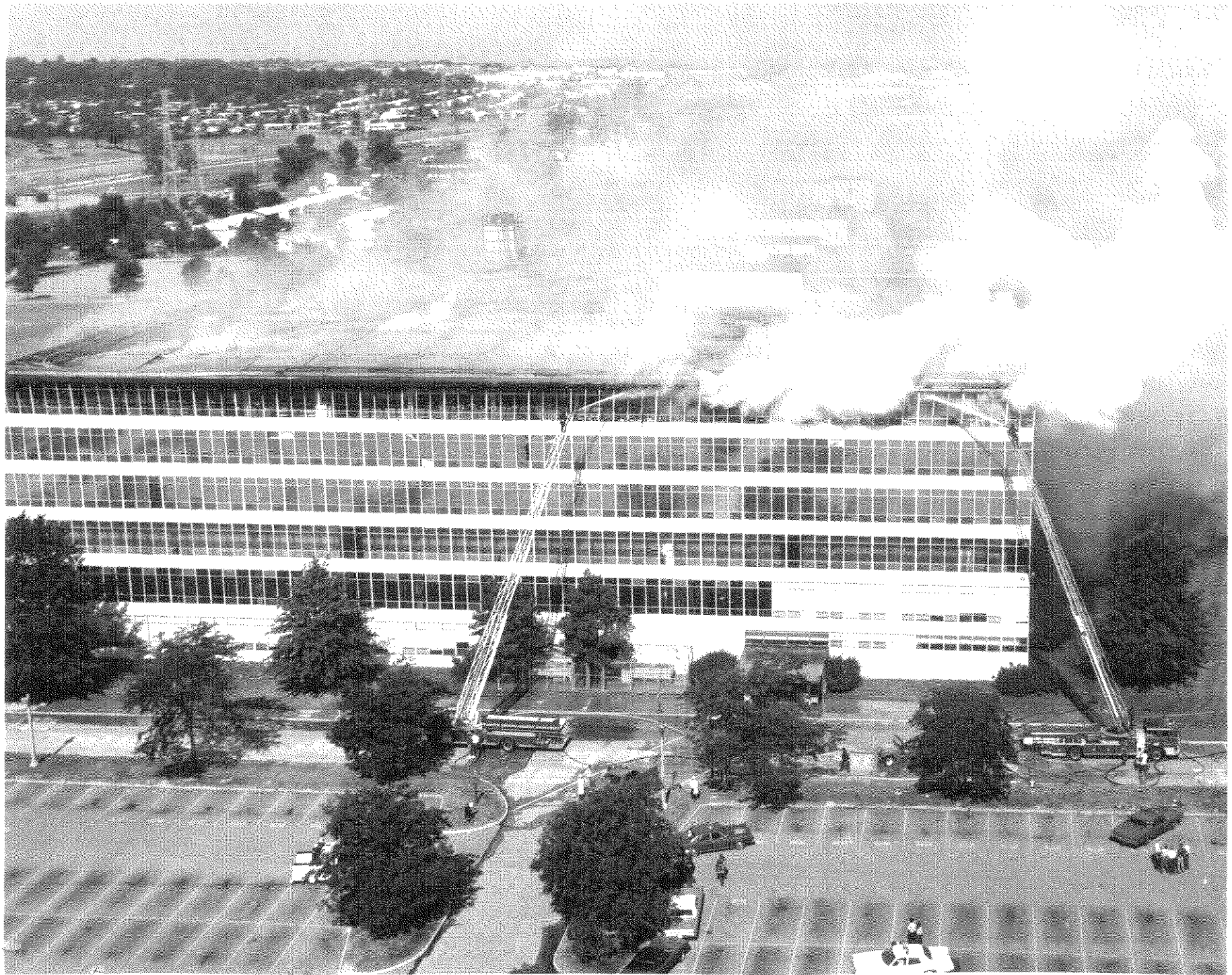

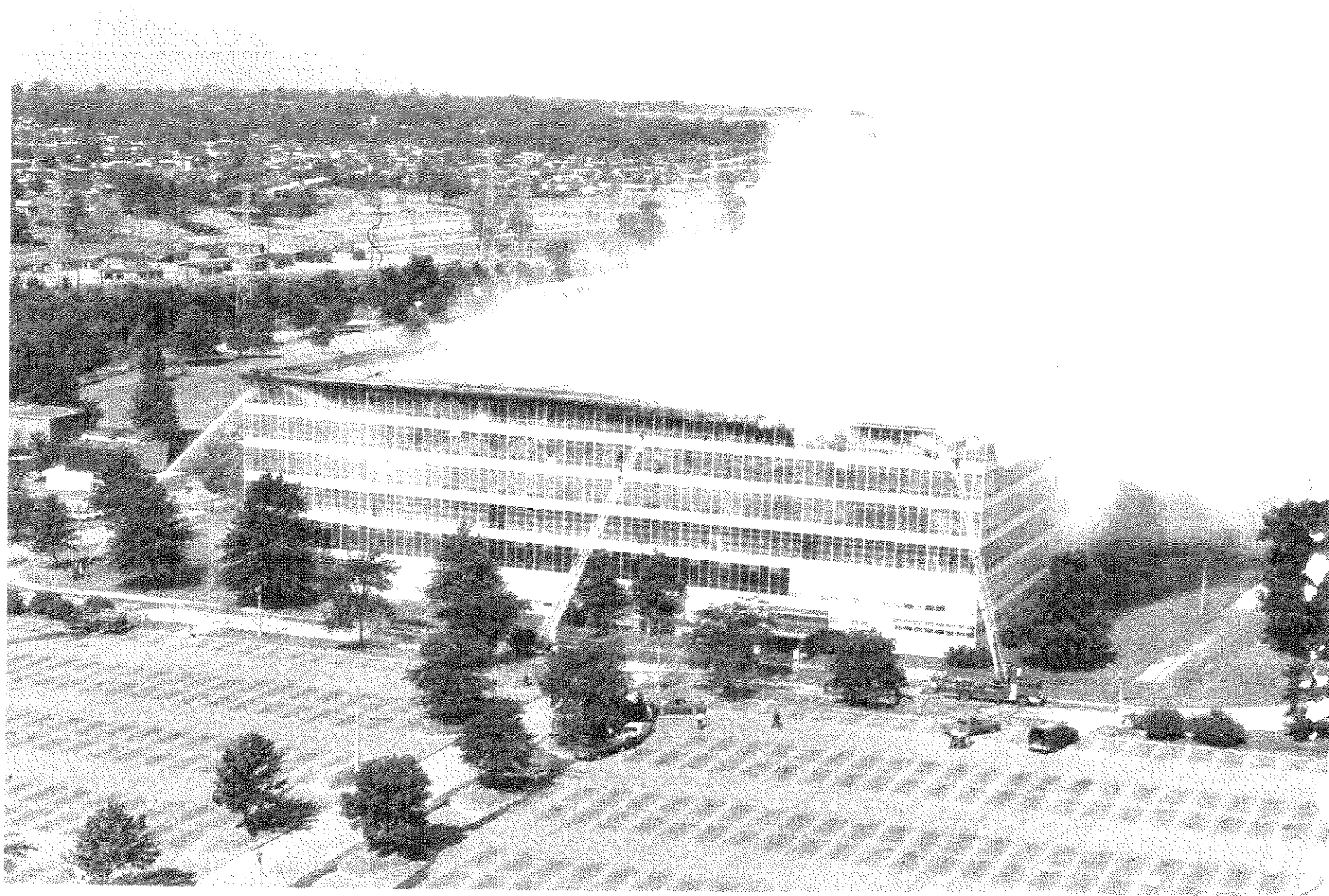

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Upon my arrival at the scene on July 12, 1973 at 0224 hours, I consulted with [redacted] of the Community Fire Protection District who was the officer in charge. [redacted] requested that I assist him in commanding the scene at the south and east ends of the building.

At approximately 0345 hours I received reports that smoke was coming from the windows or the vents on the east side of the building. I walked around to the east end of the building to a point near the main east entrance to the building. Two guards were standing at this location talking to each other about two (2) young subjects that had entered the building through the east entrance around 2345 hours of July 11, 1973. The conversation I over heard indicated that these two young subjects were employees of the record center and that they were employed under the college program. One of the guards stated that they did not locate the subjects as though they may have searched for them. One guard stated that approximately one hour after these subjects entered the building, the guard on the sixth floor discovered the fire when he opened a door during the time he was making his rounds. b7C

This information was not conveyed to anyone until the afternoon of July 13 when three (3) agents of the FBI were talking to me about their interviewing all of the guards. I mentioned this to them and they had not received any information from any of the guards they had interviewed. Respectfully submitted,
